

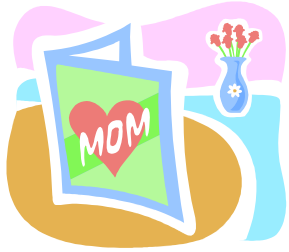

Preliminary Plans for Rhythm & Booms Event—June 28
