Dues statements will be mailed soon

Dues will increase 50 cents due to an increase in the Grand Lodge insurance program. The total due will be \$232.00. Dues are due 3/31/17 and the office appreciates everyone who pays by the due date! **PLEASE** consider donating to the optional categories on your dues statement:

- <u>Elks National Foundation</u>: For every dollar donated to the ENF, \$4.00 comes back to State and Local Lodges. The Grand Exalted Ruler has set a goal of \$4.60 to ENF from each member. Thanks to the ENF, the Elks is second only to the federal government in the amount of college scholarship money awarded. **Donations to ENF are tax deductible!**
- <u>The Wisconsin Benevolent Fund</u> gives grants to State committees such as Youth Activities, Drug Awareness, National Veterans Service, etc. This Fund also provides Wisconsin Elks Association scholarships to the scholarship applicants who move on to State judging from the local Lodges. **Donations to WBF are tax deductible!**
- <u>The State Major Project</u> is Camp Wawbeek in the Dells a respite camp for severely disabled children where the ratio of camper to counselor is never more than 2 to 1. Since 1976, the State Major Project has given nearly \$2.5 million to build several buildings at the Respite Center and upgrade several more. **Donations to SMP are tax deductible!**
- <u>Madison Elks Charities</u>: These donations fund our own educational activities, including our scholarships. We would love to build our Charities account back up to a level where we can do more for our community. **Donations to MEC are tax deductible!**
- <u>Voluntary Debt Reduction Mortgage</u> is exactly what it sounds like those monies go directly to reduce our mortgage.
- Repay Loan to Elks Charities Several years ago, when money was particularly tight, the Lodge borrowed money from Madison Elks Charities to keep the Lodge afloat. We have been paying the money back a little at a time, but we still owe nearly \$30,000 to Charities. Every dollar you donate for that option will go directly toward that debt.

The amounts listed on the dues statement are suggested donations, but you may give whatever you wish.
