## No P.E.R Meeting In August



#### A COMMUNITY PROJECT



Instead of giving out dictionaries to third graders this year, we have decided to help homeless children in the Madison area. Partnering with Porchlight, Inc., heavy-duty back packs will be purchased for the approximately 35 homeless elementary, middle and high school students in our area. The backpacks will be stuffed with school supplies required by the schools for each student, and then distributed to the children.

We have applied for a grant from the Elks National Foundation to help fund this project. But we still need monetary help from our members.

Please consider donating money to help with the purchase of backpacks and school supplies. It will cost approximately \$110 for each elementary student, \$135 for each middle schooler, and \$175 for each high school student.

Currently, the plan is for Porchlight to bring all the supplies to the Lodge and have our members partner with a student to fill the backpacks. The date for that has not yet been set, but we will send an email when it is.
