You may sponsor more than one backpack as our goal is to Supply 100 backpacks to help kids in our community succeed in school this year! Thank you!

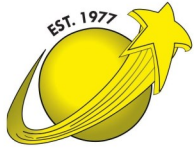

- Hannah Wendorf**, Monona Grove High School. She will be attending the San Francisco Conservatory of Music to study Viola Performance.
- Caleb Oser** was home schooled. He will attend Hillsdale College, majoring in economics

In addition, we sponsored eight \$500 scholarships to students entering Madison College, targeting Veterans returning to school.

The Ladies Auxiliary also sponsored three \$500 scholarships:
